IANSA coordinates **the Global Week of Action Against Gun Violence**, the world's largest gun violence prevention event. Activists in 65 countries took part in the Week of Action in June 2007.

The **Control Arms** campaign for a global Arms Trade Treaty (ATT) is coordinated by IANSA alongside Oxfam and Amnesty International. A major victory was achieved in December 2006 when 153 of the world's governments voted to start work on the ATT.

Members of the IANSA **Women's Network** are working to stop gun violence in the home, on the streets and on the battlefield. They are using UN Security Council Resolution 1325 to increase women's participation in disarmament processes and in the development of small arms policy and practice.

IANSA is working to implement the **UN Programme of Action** (PoA), the most comprehensive global agreement against gun violence. IANSA is the official coordinator of civil society participation, representing the voices of survivors and activists campaigning to remove guns from their communities.

IANSA members represent civil society on 35 **National Commissions on Small Arms**. These commissions are responsible for coordinating national strategies to reduce small arms proliferation and misuse.

En el marco internacional, IANSA representa las voces de la sociedad civil en el proceso de las Naciones Unidas sobre Armas Ligeras, y cuenta con la experiencia de sus miembros para promover el avance de políticas que protejan la seguridad humana.

Qu'est ce que IANSA (RAIAL) ?

Le Réseau d'Action International contre les Armes Légères (IANSA ou RAIAL), est le mouvement mondial contre la violence armée– 800 organisations de société civile qui travaillent en 120 pays pour mettre fin à la prolifération et le mauvais usage des armes à feu.

IANSA travaille pour protéger les gens de la violence armée, réduire la demande d'armes, renforcer les lois sur les armes à feu ainsi que les contrôles sur les transferts internationaux d'armes.

Dans le cadre internationale, IANSA représente la voix de la société civile dans le processus des Nations unies sur les Armes Légères, et compte avec l'expérience de ses membres pour faire avancer des politiques qui protègent la sécurité humaine.
